





About HMAI

The Objects of the Association are:

- To promote & advance the science of homoeopathy & homoeopathic education in India in accordance with the basic principles of homoeopathy, as enunciated by Hahnemann.
- To improve public health in accordance with homoeopathic principles as applied to prevalent public health methods.
- To maintain the honour & dignity & to uphold & safeguard the interests of the homoeopathic profession.
- To promote cooperation among the homoeopathic fraternity by forming a unitary national organization of the homoeopaths

For the attainment & furtherance of the above objects the association may

- Adopt measures & take steps to safeguard & protect the rights of practice & other rights appurtenant thereto, of all the registered & enlisted homoeopaths in India.
- Make effective representations to the central & state governments for establishment of medical & health service cadres for homoeopathy, for opening homoeopathic health centres & hospitals, for obtaining grants for homoeopathic institutions & for employment & absorption of homoeopathic institutionally qualified practitioners in various services including employees state insurance scheme, research schemes etc. & for directing the autonomous bodies & other undertakings to provide facilities for homoeopathic treatment to their employees.
- Arrange for maintaining & uplifting the educational, professional & ethical standard of the members
- Hold periodical meetings, congresses & conferences & arrange from time to time lectures, discussions & demonstrations in any aspect of homoeopathy & allied sciences.
- Publish & circulate a journal as official organ of the association for the homoeopathic profession.
- Provide guidelines for writing, editing, printing & or publishing text books for homoeopathic education on various preclinical & clinical subjects.









- Co-operate with or be affiliated to or associate with international homoeopathic organisations or homoeopathic organisations or bodies of other countries, not formed for the purpose of profit & whose objects are wholly or partly similar to those of the association.
- Tto affiliate any registered association subscribing to the policy & programmes of the association.
- Erect, maintain, improve, alter & keep in repair any building or buildings for the purpose of the association.
- Express its views on matters pertaining to any propose legislation affecting public health in general & homoeopathic profession & education, in particular & place the same before the central & other state governments, & take such other steps regarding the same as may be expedient from time to time.
- Establish relations with statutory bodies, boards, councils, universities, other teaching institutions, in homoeopathy in their activities, consistent with the aims & objects of the association.
- Conduct educative campaign among the masses of india in matter of public health & sanitation & participate in the public health programme organised by the government.
- Encourage research in homoeopathy & allied sciences with grants out of the funds of the association, by formation &/or maintenance, of societies of provers or other research units or committees & by establishment of scholarships, prizes, or awards & in such other manner as may be determined by the association from time to time.
- Do all such other things & adopt all such other ways & means as are cognate to the objects of the association or are incidental & conductive to the attainment of the above objects or any of them.







About New Delhi



Delhi, known locally as Dilli and by the official name National Capital Territory of Delhi (NCT), is the largest metropolis by area and the second-largest metropolis by population in India. It is the eighth largest metropolis in the world by population (which also includes Noida, Gurgaon, Greater Noida, Faridabad and Ghaziabad). The name Delhi is often also used to include some urban areas near the NCT, as well as to refer to New Delhi, the capital of India, which lies within the metropolis. The NCT is a federally administered union territory.



Located in the greater Punjab region and on the banks of the River Yamuna, Delhi has been continuously inhabited since at least the 6th century BCE. After the rise of the Delhi Sultanate, Delhi emerged as a major political, cultural and commercial city along the trade routes between northwest India and the Gangetic plain. It is the site of many ancient and medieval monuments, archaeological sites and remains.

In 1639, Mughal emperor Shahjahan built a new walled city in Delhi which served as the capital of the Mughal Empire from 1649 to 1857.



After the British East India Company had gained control of much of India during the 18th and 19th centuries, Calcutta became the capital both under Company rule and under the British Raj, until George V announced in 1911 that it was to move back to Delhi. A new capital city, New Delhi, was built to the south of the old city during the 1920s. When India gained independence from British rule in 1947, New Delhi was declared its capital and seat of government. As such, New Delhi houses important offices of the federal government, including the Parliament of India, as well as numerous national museums, monuments, and art galleries.



Owing to the migration of people from across the country, Delhi has grown to be a multicultural, cosmopolitan metropolis. Its rapid development and urbanization, coupled with the relatively high average income of its population, has transformed Delhi, Today, Delhi



Akshardham Temple Akshardham Temple in Delhi has an important place in Delhi's tourism. The structure depicts great Indian culture and its architecture is simply immaculate. This amazing structure comprises of 20,000 statues, floral motifs and exquisite carved pillars made ofstones. It is recognized as the Largest Hindu Temple Complex in the World by Guinness World Record Committee. There has not Been Use of Steel in the Whole Monument. It is a Replica of the Akshardham Temple in Ahmedabad. It is built in the Medieval Style of Architecture; Made in Pink White Marble has 234 Ornately Carved Pillars, 9 Ornate Domes, and 20 Quadrangle Shikhars









India Gate of Delhi is a 42 meter high gateway located at Rajpath, New Delhi. Also known as the 'All India War Memorial', the India Gate was planned by Sir Edwin Lutyens, who designed the New Delhi city. The foundation stone of India Gate of Delhi was laid by the Duke of Connaught. The construction of India Gate of Delhi was completed in February 1921. India Gate in Delhi is constructed as a memorial in honor of 90,000 soldiers who sacrificed their lives during World War I. 'Amar Jawan Jyoti' or the flame of the immortal warrior is burning under it since 1971. The eternal flame reminds the sacrifice of these brave soldiers. These soldiers valiantly sacrificed their lives during the Indo-Pakistan War of December 1971. India Gate in Delhi at present is a famous relaxation for the local people of Delhi in summer evenings and a popular picnic spot in winter months. The popular India Gate is located at the heart of the capital, and easily accessible by the tourists. Delhi India Gate lies at the east end of Janpath that leads to the Rashtrapati Bhawan.



Lotus Temple: The Baha'i House of Worship in Delhi, India, popularly known as the Lotus Temple due to its flowerlike shape, is a Bahá'i House of Worship and also a prominent attraction in Delhi. It was completed in 1986 and serves as the Mother Temple of the Indian subcontinent. It has won numerous architectural awards and been featured in hundreds of newspaper and magazine articles. As with all other Bahá't Houses of Worship, the Lotus Temple is open to all regardless of religion, or any other distinction, as emphasized in Bahá'i texts. The Bahá'i laws emphasize that the spirit of the House of Worship be that it is a gathering place where people of all religions may worship God without denominational restrictions. The Bahá'i laws also stipulate that only the holy scriptures of the Bahai Faith and other religions can be read or chanted inside in any language; while readings and prayers can be set to music by choirs, no musical instruments can be played inside. Furthermore no sermons can be delivered, and there can be no ritualistic ceremonies practiced.













WEATHER: During the winter season in December the weather is generally sunny and dry. The nights and early mornings can feel quite chilly but the days are warm and pleasant. Some light rain may occur. During the Third week of December, the average minimum temperature is around 8 degrees Celsius and average maximum is around 22 degrees Celsius. Woolens are the need of the hour.

By Air: Delhi's Indira Gandhi International Airport is connected to all the important cities in India and world. all most all airlines connect Delhi to the major cities in India.




By Rail: The Indian Railway with their modern and organized network connects Delhi to all major and minor destinations in India. The city has three major railway stations at New Delhi, Old Delhi, and Nizamuddin. Rajdhani Express trains connect New Delhi from the state capitals. Shatabdi Express trains connect New Delhi to the neighboring cities.



By Road: Delhi is well connected to all the major cities of India by a network of highways and roads. Buses can be taken from the three Inter State Bus Terminuses (ISBT), at Kashmere Gate, Sarai Kale Khan and Anand Vihar, as well as many starting points in and around the city, from which various statemanaged and privately run transport facilities like air conditioned, deluxe and ordinary coaches operate.
