

About Maharashtra & Aurangabad

Maharashtra is a state in the western and central peninsular region of India occupying a substantial portion of the Deccan Plateau. Maharashtra is the second-most populous state in India. It was formed on 1st May 1960. Chhatrapatí Shivaji Maharaj was an Indian ruler and a member of the Bhonsle Maratha clan. Chhatrapatí Shivaji Maharaj carved out an enclave from the declining Adilshahi sultanate of Bijapur that formed the genesis of the Maratha Empire. The Maratha Empire or the Maratha Confederacy was a power that dominated a large portion of the Indian subcontinent in the 18th century. The empire formally existed from 1674 with the coronation of Shivaji Maharaj as the 'Chhatrapati" and ended in 1818 with the defeat of Peshwa Bajirao II at the hands of the British East India Company. The Marathas are credited for ending Mughal Rule over most of the Indian subcontinent

Maharashtra has a strong religious and cultural heritage. Maharashtra has created some of the famous sants, who transformed the society. These Sants have enlightened the masses from time to time with their discourse on humanity, equality, valor, brotherhoodness and harmony. Namdev is respected for his excellent knowledge of poetry and religious discourse. He traveled entire India and reached Punjab region, where he is respected by the Sikh religious followers even today. Sant Samarth Ramdas delivered preaching on courage and noble living. The strong influence of Warkari tradition gave prominence to sants in Maharashtra. Sant Tukaram, Sant Eknath and Sant Dnyandev are considered proponents of this tradition. Sant Dnyaneshwara propagated his teachings of Bhagavad Geeta

Some of these Sants- Sant Gora Kumbhar, Sant Chokha Mela, Sant Savta Mali, Sant Janabai, Sant Tukdoji Maharaj and Sant Gadage Maharaj.

Sant Eknath, commonly known as Sant Eknath was an Indian Hindu saint, philosopher and poet. He was a devotee of the Hindu deity Krishna and is a major figure of the Warkari tradition. Sant Eknath is often viewed as a spiritual successor to the prominent Marathi saints Dnyaneshwar and

Aurangabad is a city in the Indian state of Maharashtra. It is the administrative headquarters of Aurangabad district and is the largest city in the Marathwada region. Aurangabad is the Divisional neadquarter of Marathwada region located on a hilly upland terrain in the Deccan Traps, Aurangabad is the fifth-most populous urban area in Maharashtra. The city is known as a major production centre of cotton textile and artistic silk fabrics. Several prominent educational nstitutions, including Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, are located in the city. The city is also a popular tourism hub, with tourist destinations like the Ajanta and Ellora caves lying on its outskirts, both of which have been designated as UNESCO World Heritage Sites since 983. Historically, there were 52 Gates in Aurangabad, some of them extant, because of which Aurangabad is nicknamed as the "City of Gates". In 2019, the Aurangabad Industrial City (AURIC) became the first green field industrial smart city of India under the country's flagship Smart Cities Mission.

History of Homoeopathy in Maharashtra

In Maharashtra there are 58 Homoeopathic Colleges affiliated to MUHS Nashik including P.G.Colleges. The Intake of UG 2743 and PG is 366. There are 77,200 Homeoathic practitioners in Maharashtra.Marathwada is the pioneer of P.G. Education in Homoeopathy in Maharashtra and country. Sonajirao Kshirsagar Homoeopathic Medical Medical college, Beed has started P.G Course in Homoeopathy in 1994 and Ph.D also in Homoeopathy in 2007 with the help of Late Smt.Kesharbai Kshirsagar, Ex.Mp.Beed at the first instant in Maharashtra.
